\$50,000 Powerball Win in Northeast Kansas

TOPEKA, KAN. – A Kansas Lottery player in Northeast Kansas has won an astonishing \$50,000 from the Saturday night Powerball drawing! The ticket matched four numbers and the Powerball to win! The winning numbers on July 18, 2020, were 13 - 16 - 32 - 58 - 59 and Powerball 9 and PowerPlay 2X.

The Northeast Kansas region includes the following counties: Marshall, Nemaha, Brown, Doniphan, Riley, Pottawatomie, Jackson, Atchison, Geary, Wabaunsee, Shawnee, Jefferson, Leavenworth, Wyandotte, Johnson, Osage, Douglas, Franklin, Miami, Morris, and Lyon (northern half).

The next Powerball drawing is Wednesday, July 22, with a jackpot of \$106 million. Players have until 8:59 p.m. Central Time on draw days to purchase tickets.

<u>Powerball</u> jackpots start at \$20 million. Tickets start at just \$2! There are nine ways to win, and by adding the Power Play multiplier for an additional \$1, you can multiply your win up to 10 times, except for the jackpot.
